



FISH ATOM SMASHER™

Your new Atom Smasher™ is a multi-use product designed for years of faithful service. Designed originally for use as an overflow bag when climbing Big Walls, the Atom Smasher™ can also be used as a grade IV haul bag, perhaps as a pack for the crags, or for storing all that "big iron" between nail-ups.

INSTRUCTIONS ON USE:

1. The Atom Smasher™ is delivered with the shoulder straps attached to the bag. Take note of the threading of these straps. The shoulder straps should be removed before hauling the bag.
2. Put whatever it is you intend to haul (including the shoulder straps) into the Atom Smasher™. Check the outer surface of the bag for any lumps or sharp points that might cause premature holes in the outer surface. **FIX THESE LUMPS NOW, FOR THEY WILL CAUSE HOLES LATER.** Once you've got the insides arranged, cinch down the 9/16" tube closure and secure it with a slip knot.
3. A locking carabiner should be used to secure the bag to your designated rope. If you tie the bag directly to the rope, it will be a major pain trying to get to your gear later. If you are paranoid about losing the bag, tie into one hauling loop directly with the rope, then clip the other loop into the rope with a locking biner.
4. The daisy chains on the bottom of the bag are plenty strong, but--DO NOT use these for trailing any cord attached to a human reliant. DO NOT USE THE DAISY CHAINS ON THE BOTTOM AS AN ATTACHMENT POINT FOR A CHICKEN LINE, A BACK-UP LINE, OR A JUMAR LINE! YOU WILL KILL YOUR PALS! Only use these attachment points for trailing the main haul line, (when using the 3 man or zip line system,) trailing the free Jumar line (not attached to humans,) or any spare gear that needs to be sent up to the anchor.
5. The daisy chains inside the bag are for securing things you must not lose. Clip in the camera, bolt kit, headlamp, or the 100 #0 'heads that you'll need on pitch 23 of some new horror show.
6. Inspect your bag frequently for areas of wear or damage. The daisy chains on the bottom of the bag are subject to great wear when you're dragging a loaded bag around the Camp 4 parking lot. Check these daisies for wear, and if necessary, give them a coat of "Plasti-dip™" or, "Shoe Goo II™" before further abrasion makes them unsafe.

Repairs of any worn components can be performed by Fish Products, if you're not quite up to the task.
